Dear Family Members, Loved Ones and Team Members,

This letter is to inform you that Bellaire at Devonshire began twice weekly testing for Covid-19, as ordered by Governor Justice. Results from antigen testing conducted today indicated that a team member tested positive in our community.

We are taking all the precautions recommended by the Center for Disease Control, the WV Department of Health & Human Resources, and the Putnam County Health Department. Recommendations will include Covid testing for our residents and team members. Testing will occur once weekly at Bellaire at Devonshire beginning the week of November 22, 2020. We will keep you informed as we gain information.

At this point, we will return to a “no visitation” rule. We understand completely you are missing your loved ones; however, we feel keeping these essential measures in place will continue to keep our residents safe with the hope one day soon to ease back into our normal life.

Protocol for our community is still in place and we will continue to practice these safety measures:

1. Social distancing
2. Mask wearing
3. Screening process for all team members coming to work
4. No community dining
5. All residents are wearing a surgical/cloth mask while in public areas
6. Activities department is continuing one on one visits

We do recognize that family contact and involvement are essential during these times, and we will continue to do everything we can to keep our families and residents engaged.
