Dear Residents, Families, Loved Ones and Team Members of Bellaire at Devonshire,

I am excited to announce changes to the community's visitation guidelines based on the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Effective Monday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> the community will no longer limit the frequency and length of visits for residents, the number of visitors, or require advanced scheduling of visits. Large group gatherings (parties, events, etc.) where physical distancing cannot be maintained are still not permitted, therefore, visitors are not permitted in resident group activities or group dining. During indoor visitation, we request that visitors limit movement throughout the community. Please go directly to the resident's apartment or designated visitation area.

Although there is no limit to the number of visitors that a resident can have at one time, visits should follow the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention.

- Hand Hygiene
- Face covering or mask and physical distancing at least six feet between people, by CDC guidance.
- Visitors who have a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19, or currently meet the criteria for quarantine, should not enter the community.
- The community will continue to COVID-19 screen all who enter.

Tuesday, November 19, 2021, English Meadows will be on-site from 3 pm-7 pm for a meet-and-greet with residents and their families. This period accommodates residents before dinner at 5 pm and allows for families to come after work to meet the new operators. This event will be an open house format to avoid large gatherings. Appointments are not necessary.
