Dear Residents, Families, Loved Ones and Friends of Bellaire at Devonshire,

This communication is to inform each of you that Bellaire at Devonshire has confirmed resident and team cases of COVID-19 within our community. Our community remains **in outbreak status**. WV DHHR defines an outbreak as having one or more residents or three or more employees of a Long-Term Care Facility test positive for COVID-19.

As of the time of this writing, Bellaire at Devonshire has one resident and seven employees that are considered positive for COVID-19. The resident testing positive on 1/11/22 and the most recent employee testing positive on 1/12/22. All residents and team member have been tested this week. The next scheduled PCR testing is 01/13/22 for all residents and team members. Any symptomatic individual will be tested on an as needed basis.

The outbreak status has triggered several changes that will affect the daily life of our residents and their loved ones:

- Communal dining in the Dining Room has been **temporarily suspended**. All residents will now receive meals delivered to their room, free of charge.
- Group activities have been **temporarily suspended**. Our activities team will continue to ensure that residents will be offered our enriching activities program, but on a one-on-one, in room basis.
- Non-medical outings have been **temporarily suspended**. Residents with any shopping needs during this time are encouraged to speak with the Concierge who will assist with making arrangements.
- Salon services have been **temporarily suspended**.
- Visitation **will remain available**. However, all visits must be in the resident's apartment and not in any of our public areas. If you, or your loved one, resides in a semi-private apartment, accommodations will be made for a safe space for private visitation, please see the concierge for more information. Further, we ask that all visitors strictly adhere to our mask policy and remain masked for the entire duration of their visit. Please speak to the concierge if you need a mask.

As always, our primary concern is the health and safety of our residents and teammates. We sincerely appreciate your continued support through these unprecedented times, and hope that these measures will assist us in quickly stopping the spread of COVID-19 within our community.

Visitors who have a positive viral test for Covid-19, symptoms of Covid-19, or meet the criteria for quarantine for covid19 should not enter the community. Our community will continue to screen all who enter for these exclusions. **While not recommended residents who are on transmission-based precautions can still receive visitors.** You agree that it has been disclosed that the community is in outbreak status. While it is safer for visitors to not enter the community during outbreak, we still allow visitation. However, you are being made aware of the potential risk of visitation and COVID-19 spread. You must follow the community guidelines below. For further guidance please contact the Putnam County Health Department.

- Mandatory mask wearing
- Good hand hygiene
- Social distancing
- Possibly delaying visits if you or your loved one is feeling unwell.
