Dear Residents, Families, Loved Ones and Friends of Bellaire at Devonshire,

Bellaire at Devonshire has recently conducted PCR testing on all residents and team members for the week of February 21, 2022. One resident tested positive during this round, and the community is still considered in an **outbreak**. The community must have no new cases within 2 rounds of testing and 14 days since the last confirmed case.

On February 25, 2022, the CDC recently announced updated guidelines for the public to utilize metrics such as local hospitalization rates rather than cases of COVID-19 in a county. As a result, a large majority of the nation no longer necessitates wearing a mask indoors. However, Bellaire at Devonshire is still considered a “healthcare setting” as an assisted living community. Therefore, there are no changes to our current guidance for masks currently. Please reach out if you may have any questions regarding any change of guidelines as authorities continue to evaluate.

Our team continues to always wear masks, are informed to participate in vaccination & boosters, and are regularly monitoring residents for signs or symptoms of COVID-19. For further reading on the core principles of COVID-19, they are available in the memo QSO-20-39-NH from the DHHS.

There are no changes to communal dining or group activities currently. Our community COVID-19 guidelines only affect these events when there are 2 or more cases within a five-day time frame. Resident In-room visitation will remain unaffected by social distancing guidelines
